## CFN Scholarship Qualification Guidelines

- Candidates must be children or grandchildren of active dues paying member of CFN. The recipient of this scholarship shall be determined by and through the scholarship committee of CFN.
- The funds will be used annually or as directed by the committee for one or more scholarships to full-time, under-graduate students enrolled in the University of Nebraska.
- 3. All scholarships awarded shall be for one academic year but may be renewed upon application and satisfactory performance by the recipient.
- 4. The recipient's name or names will be forwarded to the University of Nebraska on or before May 1 prior to the academic year in which the scholarship is to be awarded.
- 5. Applicants will fill out application form provided by the Scholarship Chairman which includes name, address, phone number, a brief resume of educational background, work record and extra-curricular activities. Also, a statement about the college he/she will attend and the academic discipline he/she plans to follow. A photograph should be included.
- 6. In the event that the Scholarship Committee must choose one candidate over another, the following areas will be considered:
- a. California residency
- b. Grade Point Average
- c. Extra-curricular activities
- d. Work record
- e. Academic ambitions
- f. Parents or grandparents involvement in CFN

Exceptions to the above guidelines may be made on recommendation from the Scholarship Committee and approval from the Executive Board of CFN.

7. CFN is not allowed to give Scholarships to students who will be participating in any UN sports
